Dear Ms. Zarley:

This letter confirms a visit by the Monroe Township Fire Department to your property just south of 380 County Line Road, Sunbury, Ohio wherein they advised your employee that you were open burning in violation of Ohio Administrative Code rule 3745-19-04(A). These actions are subject to fines and penalties.

Specifically, on May 17, 2011, you were burning a 30 feet by 30 feet pile of miscellaneous trash including carpet, carpet padding, mattresses and miscellaneous plastic materials.

This letter is not a final action of the Director of the Ohio EPA and is intended only as a notification of a violation of the Ohio environmental laws and regulations. It does not preclude Ohio EPA or any other governmental entity from further enforcement action.
