NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Dear Mr. Kraner:

This letter confirms my visit to your property at 4280 Wilson Road, Lancaster wherein I observed that you (or your employee) were open burning in violation of Ohio Administrative Code 3745-19-03(A). These actions are subject to fines and penalties.

Specifically, on May 10, 2011, you were open burning agriculture waste that was not "stacked and dried to provide the best practicable condition for efficient burning". There was also a tire in the fire.

This letter is not a final action of the Director of the Ohio EPA and is intended only as a notification of a violation of the Ohio environmental laws and regulations. It does not preclude Ohio EPA or any other governmental entity from further enforcement action.
