This letter confirms our conversation of August 10, 2011 wherein I advised you that you were open burning in violation of Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) 3745-19. These actions are subject to fines and penalties.

Specifically, at 19450 Five Points Pike, Monroe Township, Pickaway County, Ohio, you were open burning landscape waste within 1,000 feet from the nearest inhabited building off your premises.

This letter is not a final action of Director of Ohio EPA and is intended only as a notification of a violation of the Ohio environmental laws and regulations. It does not preclude Ohio EPA or any other governmental entity from further enforcement action.
