Dear Mr. Roberts:

This letter confirms our conversation of June 20, 2011 wherein I advised you that you were open burning in violation of Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) 3745-19-04(A). These actions are subject to fines and penalties.

Specifically, on June 18, 2011, and at 8387 US 23 N., Delaware, Ohio, you open burned a barn. Additionally this open burning occurred within 1,000 feet from the nearest inhabited building off said premises.

This letter is not a final action of the Director of the Ohio EPA and is intended only as a notification of a violation of the Ohio environmental laws and regulations. It does not preclude Ohio EPA or any other governmental entity from further enforcement action.
