Dear Mr. Bennett:

This letter confirms my visit to your property at 1890 Lawrence Road, Delaware, Ohio, wherein I advised your workers that you were open burning in violation of Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) 3745-19-04(A). These actions are subject to fines and penalties.

Specifically, on June 15, 2011, you were open burning construction debris. Additionally this open burning was occurring within 1,000 feet from the nearest inhabited building off said premises.

This letter is not a final action of the Director of the Ohio EPA and is intended only as a notification of a violation of the Ohio environmental laws and regulations. It does not preclude Ohio EPA or any other governmental entity from further enforcement action.
