This letter documents a visit by the West Licking Joint Fire District to your property at about 107 West Main Street, Kirkersville, Ohio, wherein they observed you that you were open burning in violation of Ohio Administrative Code rule 3745-19-03(A). As the property owner, you have the ultimate responsibility. These actions are subject to fines and penalties.

Specifically, on June 13, 2011, you were open burning residential waste within 1,000 feet from the nearest inhabited building off said premises.

This letter is not a final action of the Director of the Ohio EPA and is intended only as a notification of a violation of the Ohio environmental laws and regulations. It does not preclude Ohio EPA or any other governmental entity from further enforcement action.
