NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Dear Mr. Garrison:

This letter confirms our conversation of June 13, 2011 wherein I advised you that you were open burning in violation of Ohio Administrative Code 3745-19. These actions are subject to fines and penalties.

Specifically, at 11501 Woodbridge Lane, Baltimore, Ohio, you were open burning construction debris including treated fencing, fiberglass, copper wire; plastic materials, foam, a three ring binder, plastic buckets, shaft seals, and a tire. This waste material was apparently brought onsite in roll-off containers for the Garrison Company. Additionally, this waste material was being open burned within 1,000 feet from the nearest inhabited building off your premises.

We are also noting that we sent you a Notice of Violation for open burning similar items on November 7, 2007.

This letter is not a final action of the Director of the Ohio EPA and is intended only as a notification of a violation of the Ohio environmental laws and regulations. It does not preclude Ohio EPA or any other governmental entity from further enforcement action.
