This letter confirms our conversation of March 9, 2011 wherein I advised you that you were open burning in violation of Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) 3745-19. These actions are subject to fines and penalties.

Specifically, at 546 Island Road, Circleville, Ohio, you were open burning construction debris. Additionally, you were open burning miscellaneous plastic materials including a tub enclosure. Additionally, this was occurring within a restricted area and also within 1,000 feet from the nearest inhabited building off the premises.

This letter is not a final action of Director of Ohio EPA and is intended only as a notification of a violation of the Ohio environmental laws and regulations. It does not preclude Ohio EPA or any other governmental entity from further enforcement action.
