## NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Dear Mr. Colvin:

This confirms our conversation of December 30, 2010 wherein I advised you that you were open burning in violation of Ohio Administrative Code 3745-19-03(A). These actions are subject to fines and penalties.

Specifically, on December 30, 2010, and at the northwest corner of Renner and Hilliard Rome Roads, you were open burning construction debris in a restricted area. Additionally, this open burning was occurring within 1,000 feet from the nearest inhabited building off your premises. You claimed you were having a warming fire but the fire was about 10 feet in diameter which is certainly larger than the intended purpose. Also, the temperature was about 50 degrees.

This letter is not a final action of the Director of the Ohio EPA and is intended only as a notification of a violation of the Ohio environmental laws and regulations. It does not preclude Ohio EPA or any other governmental entity from further enforcement action.
