NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Dear Mr. Anderson:

This letter confirms a visit to your property on State Route 146 (.5 miles east of Muskingum County), Hanover, Ohio by the Hanover Volunteer Fire Department, wherein they observed that you were open burning in violation of Ohio Administrative Code rule 3745-19-04(A). These actions are subject to fines and penalties. As the property owner, you have the ultimate responsibility.

Specifically, on June 21, 2010, you (or your manager, Herman Simpson) were open burning tires, furniture, rubber hoses, paint cans, fiberglass, a hydraulic hose, a tractor seat, a garage door and many other miscellaneous items. Additionally this open burning was occurring within 1,000 feet from the nearest inhabited building off your property.

This letter is not a final action of the Director of Ohio EPA and is intended only as a notification of a violation of the Ohio environmental laws and regulations. It does not preclude Ohio EPA or any other governmental entity from further enforcement action.
