Dear Mr. Lightfoot:

This confirms our conversation on your property at 8684 Alkire, Darbydale, Ohio on June 16, 2008, wherein I advised you that you have been open burning in violation of Ohio Administrative Code 3745-19. These actions are subject to fines and penalties.

Specifically, you were burning landscape waste within 1,000 feet from the nearest inhabited building off said premises.

We are also noting that we sent a previous warning letter dated May 19, 2003 to the resident at 8684 Alkire.

We also sent a Notice of Violation on July 20, 2007 to Mr. Boso, the owner of the property, and we copied you with same.

You also talked about having a July 4 bonfire. Recreational fires can be no larger than 3 feet in diameter by 2 feet high fuel area and must be fueled by clean seasoned firewood or cleaner material. You also need to extinguish the fire when done.

This letter is not a final action of the Director of Ohio EPA and is intended only as a notification of a violation of the Ohio environmental laws and regulations. It does not preclude Ohio EPA or any other governmental entity from further enforcement action.
