The Underground Injection Control (UIC) Section of Ohio EPA's Division of Drinking and Ground Waters (DDAGW) received Southern Ohio Coal Company's (SOCCo) monthly reports for March 2013 and quarterly reports for the first quarter 2013 were submitted on April 11, 2013. Monthly and quarterly reports were submitted for the following permits:

	<u>Class V UIC Permit</u>
Meigs Mine No. 2	UIC 05-53-01-PTO-V
Meigs Mine No. 31	UIC 05-53-10-PTO-V
Meigs Mine No. 31 AMD Sludge	UIC 05-53-34-PTO-V

These monthly and quarterly reports demonstrate compliance with the requirements of SOCCo's Class V UIC permits and Chapter 3745-34 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC).

The monthly report for March 2013 and quarterly report for the first quarter 2013 were also submitted on April 11, 2013 for Raccoon No. 3. The monthly and quarterly reports are not in compliance with the requirements of SOCCo's Class V UIC permit: UIC 05-82-01-PTO-V because they were missing a copy of Alloway's lab sheets. In addition, I did not see a value for Aluminium in the injection fluid. Please include a copy of the March 2013 lab sheet for the result of the injected fluids with the April 2013 monthly operating report.
