### NOTICE OF VIOLATION – ACTION REQUIRED

**Subject: Failure to Sample Source Water for Fecal Indicators (Total Coliform) and Failure to Conduct Required Treated Water Repeat Total Coliform Monitoring as Required**

Maranatha Bible Church is in violation of Federal Code, Rule 141.402 for failure to comply with the Ground Water Rule monitoring.

Also, Maranatha Bible Church is in violation of monitoring requirements for Total Coliform established by Ohio Administrative Code (OAC), Rule 3745-81-21 for Third Quarter of 2010.

Ohio EPA records indicate that a total coliform-positive sample was collected from this water system on 8/19/2010 and all of the required repeat samples were not collected. To ensure the safety of drinking water provided by your system monitoring with all of the required repeat samples is essential.

**ACTION REQUIRED:**

1. **To address these violations, return to compliance, and prevent state and federal enforcement action:**
  - a. **The required source water samples must be collected. Failure to collect the required source water sample(s) may result in enforcement action by the United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA).** If source water (raw) samples were collected as required, submit the results to the appropriate Ohio EPA District Office as soon as possible. The monitoring violation would be rescinded and a reporting violation given for late submittal of the results. If raw water samples were not collected, they must still be collected and Ohio EPA must receive results to return to compliance and prevent referring this violation to USEPA.
  - b. **Monitor with at least five (5) routine samples** in the month following a routine total coliform-positive result in accordance with OAC, Rule 3745-81-21(B)(7). **Five (5) routine samples must be collected on or before September 30, 2010**

2. **Notify the people served by this water system** using one or more of the methods and the timing as required by OAC, Rule 3745-81-32 to reach all persons served.


**Timing:** As soon as practical, but no later than 30 days after learning of the violation:

- 1) Posting in conspicuous location, such as bulletin boards, restrooms, drinking fountains, vending areas;
- 2) Mail or other direct delivery to each customer;
- 3) Newsletters or newspaper;
- 4) E-mail to employees or students;
- 5) Send to parents or guardians of children at schools or day care facilities
- 6) Posted notices must remain in place as long as the violation or situation exists, but in no case less than seven days (even if the violation is resolved). The language in italics on the enclosed public notice is mandatory and must be included, as written. Do not make changes to the public notice without consulting with the Ohio EPA beforehand.

3. **Complete the enclosed Verification Form within 10 days of issuing the Public Notice** and mail it to Ohio EPA - SEDO. Include a copy of each notice distributed, published or posted.

# DRINKING WATER NOTICE

## Source Monitoring requirements were not met for Maranatha Bible Church

We are required to monitor our source (raw) water for fecal indicators following a positive sample for total coliform in our distribution system. During August 2010, we did not complete all monitoring or testing for total coliform bacteria, and therefore cannot be sure of the quality of your drinking water during that time.

Also, we were required to collect four repeat samples of the finished water within 24 hours of notification of any total coliform positive result to determine if *E. coli* or fecal coliform bacteria were present. These bacteria can make you sick, and are a particular concern for people with weakened immune systems. We did not collect all the required repeat samples.

### What Should I Do?

*There is nothing you need to do at this time. You do not need to boil your water or take other corrective actions. If a situation arises where the water is no longer safe to drink, you will be notified within 24 hours.*

### What is being done?

Upon being notified of this violation, the water supply was required to have the drinking water analyzed for the above mentioned parameters and post this public notice to inform our customers. Maranatha Bible Church will take steps to ensure that adequate monitoring will be performed in the future.

Public notice issued by other methods shall be repeated annually as long as the violation or situation persists.
