**RE: Village of Cedarville Closed Landfill
2012 Annual Operational Report and Post-Closure Care Quarterly Reports
Notice of Violation**

Dear Mr. Terrell:

The Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA), Southwest District Office (SWDO) has **not** received the 2012 Village of Cedarville Closed Landfill Annual Report or the first quarter 2013 Post-Closure Care Report to date. By failing to submit these required reports the Village of Cedarville is in violation of the following:

1. The Annual Post-Closure Report for Landfill Facilities was due April 1, 2013. Failure to submit the report by April 1, 2013 is a violation of Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-27-14(A)(6), which states in part;

Post-closure care activities for a sanitary landfill facility shall include, but are not limited to... Submitting a report to the appropriate Ohio EPA district office and approved health department ... not later than the first day of April of each year.

Please ensure the Village of Cedarville submits this report as soon as possible on the appropriate form and that a cost estimate be provided.

2. The first quarter Post-Closure Care Report is late. This report is to be submitted within 15 days of completing the quarterly post closure inspection. This is a violation of OAC Rule 3745-27-14(A)(4) which states in part;

Post-closure care activities for a sanitary landfill facility shall include, but are not limited to ... Quarterly inspection of a sanitary landfill facility during each year of the post-closure care period and submittal of a written summary to the appropriate Ohio EPA district office not later than fifteen days after the inspection date detailing the results of the inspection and a schedule of any actions to be taken to maintain compliance...


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Please ensure these reports are submitted in a manner that they can be received by this office within the required timeframe. In addition, please revise the report format to include the date that Village personnel conduct the quarterly inspection. Past reports do not include the date of the inspection.

Nothing in this letter shall be construed to authorize any waiver from the requirements of any applicable state or federal laws or regulations. This letter shall not be interpreted to release the owner or operator, or others, from responsibility under Chapters 3704, 3714, 3734, or 6111 of the Ohio Revised Code or under the Federal Clean Water Act, Resource Conservation and Recovery Act, or Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act for remedying conditions resulting from any release of contaminants to the environment.
