Dear Mr. Barbini:

I am writing this letter in response to an open burning report received by this office on April 15, 2013.

Upon inspection on April 15, 2013, the site of open burning was observed toward the rear of the Hocking Valley Canoe Livery. The fire had been extinguished by the Logan Fire Department. There was evidence of trash, plastics, paper and other solid waste materials observed in the open burn area. Business cannot burn any type of waste for disposal purposes. Plastics cannot be burned anywhere in Ohio.

Open burning of improper waste materials at this location is in violation of Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) rule 3745-19-03 and is punishable by a fine. If you continue to open burn improper waste materials at this location or any other location in Ohio, legal action will be taken against you.

The Ohio EPA may seek civil penalties as provided in section 3704.06 of the Ohio Revised Code. The determination to pursue or to decline to pursue such penalties in this case will be made by Ohio EPA at a later date.
