Dear Mr. Wright:

On April 25, 2013, I inspected Tomahawk Car Care located at 9011 Market Street, North Lima, Ohio. The purpose of this was to determine if this facility was in compliance with Ohio's hazardous waste, universal waste and used oil laws and rules as found in Chapter 3734 of the Ohio Revised Code (ORC) and Chapter 3745 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC).

You told me that your drum of hazardous waste painting cleanup solvent is about full and that you plan to have it picked up soon. I suggest you keep a copy of the manifest for this at your shop. You can also send a copy to me and I will keep it in our file if you like.

The following violation was found: (See also the enclosed checklist.)

1. **OAC Rule 3745-52-11 – Hazardous waste determination.**

This rule requires that any person who generates a waste must determine if that waste is a hazardous waste.

Tomahawk Car Care violated this rule by disposing of waste lamps (including fluorescent lamps) with regular trash without determining whether or not they are a hazardous waste. Fluorescent and some other types of lamps contain mercury and may contain other hazardous metals. When burned out they may be a hazardous waste. In general, waste lamps should be saved in a properly labeled and closed container (such as a cardboard box) and picked up by a lamp recycler. You told me that you will now do this for any waste lamps generated.
