Dear Mr. Brooks:

Thank you for your February 5, 2011, response to Ohio EPA's January 27, 2011, Notice of Violation (NOV) letter. My review of the documentation submitted reveals that Steve's Family Auto (hereafter referred to as SFA) has adequately demonstrated abatement of the violation cited in the January 27, 2011, NOV.

The following is a summary of the violation cited in the January 27, 2011, NOV as a result of our January 12, 2011, inspection and your compliance with respect to it:

1. OAC Rule 3745-279-22(C)(1): Labeling:

Containers, aboveground tanks, and fill pipes used for underground storage tanks shall be labeled or marked clearly with the words "used oil."

SFA had three portable used oil containers that were not properly labeled.

In order to correct this violation, SFA must properly label the three portable containers with the words "used oil" and submit photographic documentation to Ohio EPA.

On January 15, 2011, SFA submitted, via electronic mail, a photograph of the three portable used oil storage containers labeled "waste oil only". On January 18, 2011, the Ohio EPA responded to your electronic mail letting you know that the labels on the portable used oil containers did not meet the regulation requirements. This violation has not been abated.

On February 5, 2011, SFA submitted, via electronic mail, a photograph of one portable used oil storage container now properly labeled "used oil". SFA must ensure that all containers in use at your facility are properly labeled with the words "used oil".

With this information, this violation has been abated.
