Thank you for your May 6, 2013 e-mail response to Ohio EPA's April 24, 2013 Notice of Violation letter. The documentation you submitted included your statement indicating universal waste lamps will now be recycled and that the correct facility hazardous waste number will be used for future waste management. You also included a photocopy of the posted emergency procedures and a recent emergency equipment and hazardous waste container inspection checklist.
