WARNING LETTER

On December 5, 2012 the Regional Air Pollution Control Agency (RAPCA) received a report from the Lewisburg Fire Department which contained information about an illegal burn at 9331 Euphemia Castine Rd. in Lewisburg, OH. The Fire Department's response and investigation found tires burning at this address. According to the Fire Department, this is not the only open burning incident response to this address. The open burning that occurred is a violation of state air pollution control regulations. As the property owner and individual responsible for the open burning, you are hereby notified of these findings and ordered to cease all unauthorized open burning activities.

Pursuant to Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) rule Regulations section 3745-19-04, **Open Burning in Unrestricted Areas**, the open burning of petroleum products such as tires for waste disposal is strictly prohibited in the state of Ohio. The open burning that has occurred at this property is a violation of OAC rule 3745-19-04 and Revised Code (ORC) 3704.05.


This letter serves as official notification of the aforementioned violations and to cease all unauthorized open burning activities immediately. RAPCA believes the above open burning to be a serious matter and requires that, within 14 days of receipt of this letter, you submit a written commitment to maintain compliance with all open burning regulations in the future. This commitment shall include a detailed plan for disposing of any the remaining tires and waste materials. The manner of waste disposal shall comply with all applicable air and solid waste regulations.

Acceptance of this compliance plan by RAPCA does not constitute a waiver of the Ohio EPA's and RAPCA's authority to seek civil penalties as provided in sections 3704.06 and 3707.49 of the Revised Code. The determination whether to pursue or not to pursue such penalties will be made by the Ohio EPA and RAPCA at a later date.
