Dear Mr. Matthews:

On May 10, 2013, Ohio EPA received a complaint that the APEX Landfill may be disposing of bulk liquids. On May 14, 2013, I conducted an investigation regarding the complaint that was received on May 10, 2013.

At the time of my investigation it was determined that during the week of May 6, 2013, Apex had a contractor on site cleaning the leachate collection sumps as well as the piping network. At the time of my investigation it was determined that at a vacuum truck load of leachate generated on site was disposed of at the working face. Therefore, the Apex Landfill is in violation of disposing of bulk liquids and specifically the following regulation:

(8) Disposal restrictions:

The owner or operator shall not accept for disposal or dispose of any of the following materials at a sanitary landfill facility:

(b) Containerized bulk liquids or non-containerized liquids without authorization from the director.

At the time of my inspection the facility was not in compliance with Ohio Administrative Code 3734-27-19. Please provide information to show that Apex Landfill has returned to compliance and the steps taken to prevent any further violations of the aforementioned regulation.
