On March 18, 2013, Ohio EPA issued a notice of violation for failure to control leachate and for failure to construct the solidification area according to the authorizing documents. The aforementioned violations came as the result of an inspection conducted on March 6, 2013. On March 15, 2013, Ohio EPA received a letter from you responding to the aforementioned notice of violation.

Based on the information submitted within your letter and an on-site inspection conducted by Ohio EPA on April 16, 2013, Ohio EPA concurs that the violation has been abated. At this time it appears the facility has returned to compliance.
