Dear Mr. Thurlow:

On August 13, 2007, I received your quarterly deviation reports for the first and second quarters of 2007 which were due on 4/30/07 and 7/31/07, respectively. A full review of Reserve Equipment, Inc files indicate that several gaps in submission of the reports have occurred in the past resulting in formal and informal requests to submit the reports on time.

The following list details which reports are missing in our files:

2004 - 4<sup>th</sup> quarter due 1/31/05, received 10/17/06  
2005 - 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3, and 4<sup>th</sup> quarters received on 10/17/06  
2007 - 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> quarters received on 8/13/07

The Ohio EPA requests that all missing reports be submitted within 30 days. Also, a formal compliance plan is requested within the same 30 day interval that will ensure the timely submission of all future reports. Prior plans submitted by Reserve Equipment, Inc. have failed. Therefore, a new compliance plan must be drafted and accepted by the Ohio EPA. Acceptance by the Ohio EPA of a schedule for compliance does not constitute a waiver of the Ohio EPA's authority to seek civil penalties as provided in section 3704.06 of the Ohio Revised Code. The determination to pursue or decline to pursue such penalties in this case will be made by the Ohio EPA at a later date.
