Dear Mr. Reese:

On February 12, 1998, Scio Packaging Company, Inc., was issued permits to operate which required annual deviation reporting of visible emission (VE) exceedances for emission units:

- F004 - Material Handling Transfer and Conveying;
- F005 - Cement Silo Filling and Loadout;
- F006 - Mixer #1 to Silos and Loading;
- P901 - Bagging #1; and
- P904 - 150 tph Block Blender with 4 silos, pneumatic filling and gravity truck loading.

The reporting requirements for these emission units was previously cited in a September 1, 2004 warning letter. The annual reports are due by February 15 of the following calendar year. To date, none of these reports have been received.

A report should contain the following information:

- Facility Name, Facility ID number and Emission unit ID(s);
- The type of report (i.e., Quarterly deviation report, Annual deviations report, ...);
- The date the report was prepared;
- The time period for which the report is for;
- The date the report is due;
- The information required by the reporting requirements in the permit (technical data), or in the instance of a deviation - identify the deviation, the date and duration over which it occurred and what corrective actions were taken to remedy it and prevent future occurrences;
- Reports in which no deviation events occurred shall contain a negative declaration statement, which states that no deviations occurred during the specified reporting period; and
- Be signed by the responsible official.

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Please submit the above information within 30 days of receipt of this letter. If Scio Packaging does not have the records available to generate the annual reports, that should be indicated in your response.

Acceptance by the Ohio EPA of delinquent reports does not constitute a waiver of the Ohio EPA's authority to seek civil penalties as provided in section 3704.06 of the Ohio Revised Code. The determination to pursue or decline to pursue such penalties in this case will be made by the Ohio EPA at a later date.
