Dear Mr. and Mrs. Lemon:

I am writing this letter in response to complaints received by this office on January 7 and 14, 2009. The complaints allege that you are open burning plastics, diapers, garbage and other solid wastes that are hauled from other locations to your home.

On January 13, 2009, I investigated this complaint and spoke to both of you. There was a fire in the burn barrel at the time of my inspection. The barrel was almost full with ashes. This indicates that there has been a considerable amount of open burning at this location. I also observed where Styrofoam and part of a water bed had been open burned. You told me that you do now have trash pickup and do not haul any wastes to this property from off site to be burned.

As I explained at the time of my visit, plastics, diapers, Styrofoam, garbage, etc., cannot be open burned in Ohio. No wastes that are hauled in to a property can be open burned. The open burning of improper waste materials at this location is in violation of Ohio Administrative Code rule 3745-19-04 and is punishable by a fine. If you continue to open burn improper waste materials, legal action may be taken against you.
