Notice of Violation – 2nd Notice**

Dear Mr. Terrell:

Ohio EPA, Southwest District Office (SWDO) has **not** received the 2012 Village of Cedarville Closed Landfill Annual Report to date. The Annual Post-Closure Report for Landfill Facilities was due April 1, 2013. Failure to submit the report by April 1, 2013 is a violation of Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-27-14(A)(6), which states in part;

“Post-closure care activities for a sanitary landfill facility shall include, but are not limited to... Submitting a report to the appropriate Ohio EPA district office and approved health department ... not later than the first day of April of each year.”


The Village was previously made aware of this violation in a letter dated April 18, 2013. Please ensure the village of Cedarville submits this report as soon as possible on the appropriate form and also provide a cost estimate.

Nothing in this letter shall be construed to authorize any waiver from the requirements of any applicable state or federal laws or regulations. This letter shall not be interpreted to release the owner or operator, or others, from responsibility under Chapters 3704, 3714, 3734, or 6111 of the Ohio Revised Code or under the Federal Clean Water Act, Resource Conservation and Recovery Act, or Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act for remedying conditions resulting from any release of contaminants to the environment.
