Dear Ms. Halowell:

I am writing this letter in response to a complaint received by this office on April 8, 2009. The complaint alleges that you open burn your household trash in barrels in your yard.

On April 9, 2009, I investigated this complaint. You were not at home at the time of my investigation. I left my business card and a pamphlet in your front door. The pamphlet explains Ohio's open burning rules. Evidence of the open burning of plastics, paper, garbage and other solid wastes was observed. Garbage and plastics cannot be open burned in Ohio. To open burn residential waste such as paper, leaves, cardboard, tree trimmings, etc., your property must be located in an unrestricted area. Because your property is not in an unrestricted area, you cannot open burn residential waste at this location.

Open burning improper waste materials is in violation of Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) rule 3745-19-03 and is punishable by a fine. If you continue to open burn improper waste materials, legal action will be taken against you.
