In a letter dated March 15, 2013 the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) provided notice of violation occurring at the Hancock County Landfill (Facility) located at 3763 Co Rd 140, Findlay, Ohio. On May 7, 2013 and June 4, 2013, Ohio EPA received documents titled "Revisions to the Groundwater Quality Assessment Plan; Hancock County Sanitary Landfill" dated May 6, 2013 and June 3, 2013, respectively. Ohio EPA has reviewed the above referenced documents and determined the Facility has returned to compliance and abated the following violation:
