On June 14, 2013, Ohio EPA received your response to my March 11, 2013, Partial Return to Compliance Letter regarding outstanding violations discovered during a compliance evaluation inspection conducted on November 23 and 24, 2010.

My review of this documentation reveals that Akzo Nobel Paints, LLC has abated all the violation discovered during the November 23 and 24, 2010, compliance evaluation inspection as listed below:

1. OAC Rule 3745-66-91(B)(4), Assessment of Existing Tank Systems' Integrity – Documented age of the tank system.

***This violation was abated June 29, 2012.***

2. OAC Rule 3745-66-98(B) Special Requirements for ignitable or reactive waste.

***This violation was abated June 29, 2012.***

3. OAC Rule 3745-66-93(C)(1) Containment and detection of releases – Secondary containment construction requirements including waste compatibility.

***This violation was abated June 14, 2013***

4. OAC Rule 3745-66-93(C)(3) Containment and detection of releases – leak detection.

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5. OAC Rule 3745-66-93(C)(4) Containment and detection of releases – Liquid Drainage.

***This violation was abated June 29, 2012.***

6. OAC Rule 3745-66-93(E)(1) Containment and detection of releases – External Liner.

***This violation was abated on June 14, 2013.***

7. OAC Rule 3745-66-93(F) Containment and detection of releases – Ancillary Equipment.

***This violation was abated on June 19, 2013.***
