Dear Ms. Kaiser:

On May 29, 2013, Ohio EPA received a letter dated May 24, 2013 from Ross Incineration Services Inc. (RIS) in which RIS voluntarily disclosed an instance of noncompliance with a permit condition pursuant to Permit Condition A.22, specifically:

- Internal tank inspections had not been completed within the 10 year time period specified in Condition D.5(e) of RIS' Ohio Hazardous Waste Permit.

The letter also noted that RIS took the following steps to abate the violation and to prevent reoccurrence:

- Visual inspection of the overdue tanks had been completed by May 17, 2013.
- RIS had begun inspection of the other tanks for which an internal inspection is required in 2013.
- RIS had created a master list of tank inspections.

The overdue tank inspections and other issues related to the tank inspection and tank corrosion monitoring program were discussed in a meeting between RIS and Ohio EPA DMWM held at Ohio EPA's NEDO office on June 21, 2013.
