On October 9 and 10, 2007, Scott Bergreen and I conducted a compliance evaluation inspection of the Organic Technologies (OT) facility in Coshocton for compliance with Ohio's hazardous waste laws and regulations, as found in the Ohio Revised Code and the Ohio Administrative Code (ORC and OAC, respectively).

As a result of the inspection, a notice of violation was issued on October 22, 2007. On November 15, I received your response. Based on the documentation you provided with your response, OT has returned to compliance with the following regulations:

- i) OAC rule 3745-65-52(D), Content of contingency plan;
- ii) OAC rule 3745-655-54, Amendment of contingency plan;
- iii) OAC rule 273-13(D)(1), Waste management-standards for small quantity handlers of universal waste;
- iv) OAC 3745-273-14(E), Labeling/marketing standards for small quantity handlers of universal waste;
- v) OAC rule 3745-273-15(C), Accumulation time limits.
