Thank you for your responses to Ohio EPA's April 18, 2013, Notice of Violation letter (NOV). The following information was submitted:

- On May 10, 2013, via email Mr. Jim Smith submitted 1) analytical which indicates your parts washing solvent is hazardous for cadmium (D006) (the parts washing fluid is mixed with used oil for burning in the on-site used oil burners and 2) the Material Safety Data Sheet for the current parts washing solvent (467 Solvent) in use at the facility;
- On May 17, 2013, via email Mr. Jim Smith submitted information outlining the future management of the parts washing fluid.

My review of this information reveals that Hanson Aggregates has adequately demonstrated abatement of the violations discovered during the March 28, 2013, inspection as listed below:


