Dear Mr. Laube:

Thank you for your June 12, 2013, response to Ohio EPA's May 14, 2013, Notice of Violation-Partial Return to Compliance (NOV-PRTC) letter. Laube's Transmission & Service Center (LTSC) submitted universal waste documentation. My review of the documentation submitted reveals that LTSC has adequately demonstrated abatement of all of the violations cited in the May 14, 2013, NOV-PRTC.

The following is a summary of the violations cited in the May 14, 2013, NOV-PRTC as a result of Ohio EPA's April 30, 2013, inspection and your compliance with respect to each:

**1. Waste Evaluation: OAC Rule 3745-52-11:**

Any person who generates a waste must determine if that waste is a hazardous waste by using generator knowledge or by testing the waste.

LTSC failed to have waste evaluation documentation or an established recycling plan in place for the fluorescent bulbs generated at the facility.

**On June 12, 2013, LTSC submitted information regarding universal waste lamps. LTSC plans to manage the spent lamps as universal waste and has arranged for Gross Electric in Toledo, Ohio, to pick them up for recycling once a year.**

***With this information, this violation has been abated.***

**2. Labeling: OAC Rule 3745-279-22(C)(1):**

Containers, aboveground tanks, and fill pipes used for underground storage tanks shall be labeled or marked clearly with the words "used oil."

LTSC had one storage tote and two portable containers of used oil that were not properly labeled.

***This violation was previously abated on April 30, 2013.***
