Dear Mr. Dottore:

This is in reference to Harvard Refuse Landfill's submittal of quarterly post-closure care inspection reports for the closed Harvard Refuse Landfill. Please note that the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-27-14(A)(4) requires the owner/operator of a closed landfill to submit post-closure care inspection reports to Ohio EPA no later than fifteen days after the inspection date. Ohio EPA did not receive the reports for the 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th quarters from 2010 through 2012 and 1st, 2nd and 3rd for 2013.

In order to comply with OAC Rule 3745-27-14(A)(4), please submit a response within 14 days of receipt of this letter, indicating how the facility has returned to compliance with the OAC Rule 3745-27-14(A)(4).

Nothing in this letter shall be construed to authorize any waiver from the requirements of any applicable state or federal laws or regulations. This letter shall not be interpreted to release the Entity from responsibility under Chapters 3704, 3714, 3734, or 6111 of the Ohio Revised Code or under the Federal Clean Water or Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Acts for remedying conditions resulting from any release of contaminants to the environment.
