The documentation you submitted included a description of how the used oil drums, that were identified as being unlabeled during Ohio EPA's April 12, 2013 inspection, are now labeled. On July 31, 2013, I sent you an email requesting that you submit photographic documentation demonstrating the drums were now labeled with the words "Used Oil". You submitted the photographic documentation by email on August 5, 2013.


My review of this documentation reveals that Senco has now abated the violation discovered during the April 12, 2013, inspection as listed below.
