Dear Mr. Ruck:

Thank you for sending the response to my June 19, 2013, Partial Return to Compliance (PRTC). Your response was received by the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) on August 1, 2013, and included analytical results from sampling the used oil absorbent.

Review of the submitted documentation, reveals that General Service Garage Inc. (GSGI) has abated all violations discovered during the April 15, 2013, compliance evaluation inspection, as outlined below. GSGI will remain a conditionally exempt small quantity generator of hazardous waste and a generator of used oil, universal waste lamps, and lead acid batteries (core exchange/recycle).

In an attempt to streamline this letter, details concerning previously abated violations or general concerns which have been addressed in previous correspondence have been omitted.

Violations:

1. **Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-52-11, Hazardous Waste Determination:**
"Any person who generates a waste, as defined in rule 3745-51-02 of the Administrative Code, must determine if that waste is a hazardous waste..."

GSGI failed to adequately evaluate the waste streams listed below to determine if they were a hazardous waste in accordance with OAC Rule 3745-52-11.

- a. Spent lamps-Abated on May 17, 2013.
- b. Used oil absorbent-GSGI uses a kitty litter type absorbent to clean up used oil spills around the facility. The waste used oil absorbent is then disposed of by being thrown into the trash. GSGI generates approximately 50 pounds of this waste stream every month.

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On August 1, 2013, Ohio EPA received analytical results from sampling the used oil absorbent. These results show the used oil absorbent is a non-hazardous waste and can be managed as such.

Therefore, portion b. of this violation is considered abated on August 1, 2013.

2. OAC Rule 3745-279-22 (C)(1)-Abated on April 15, 2013.
