Dear Ms. Rodabaugh:

In a letter dated July 19, 2013, the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA), provided a notice of violation occurring at Marshfield Food Safety (Facility). On July 25, 2013, Ohio EPA received an e-mail correspondence that included a proposed disposal paper from you in response to the notice of violation. On August 5, 2013, Ohio EPA received a scanned copy of a signed and dated disposal paper that is accompanying the treated infectious waste to the disposal facility. These submittals document abatement of the following violation:
