Thank you for your recent responses to Ohio EPA's July 22, 2013 Notice of Violation letter to SOMC Cancer Center. The documentation you submitted on July 30, 2013 included photographs demonstrating that all spent lamps have been containerized, and the containers of spent lamps have been labeled with the words "Used Lamps". Documentation submitted on July 31, 2013 demonstrated that SOMC's Main Campus has arranged with PSC Environmental to manage all spent lamps as universal waste to be recycled. SOMC Cancer Center may now resume sending their spent lamps to the main campus (another handler destination) for pick-up from the recycling company.

My review of the documentation you submitted reveals that SOMC Cancer Center has now abated all violations discovered during the July 10, 2013 hazardous waste inspection.
