Subject: Failure to Monitor Drinking Water

Twin City Water And Sewer District PWS is in violation of Ohio Administrative Code Rule (OAC) 3745-81-24 for failing to monitor your drinking water during the Second Quarter of 2013 monitoring period and/or report results for the following contaminants: TOTAL TRIHALOMETHANES (TTHM), HALOACETIC ACIDS, FIVE (HAA5).

In order to return to compliance, Twin City Water And Sewer District PWS must take the following actions:

1. Notify your customers using the enclosed instructions and public notice.
2. Complete and send a verification form with a copy of the public notice to the mailing address below.
3. Promptly collect your next sample according to your most recent monitoring schedule.
4. Submit the sample for analysis to a certified laboratory on the enclosed list.

Your prompt attention to this matter is greatly appreciated. Continued noncompliance may lead to enforcement actions. If you have any questions, or if the required sample analysis was performed, please call me at (614) 644-2752.

DRINKING WATER NOTICE

Monitoring requirements not met for Twin City Water And Sewer District PWS

We are required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not our drinking water meets health standards. During the Second Quarter of 2013 time period we did not monitor for the following contaminants and therefore cannot be sure of the quality of our drinking water during that time: TOTAL TRIHALOMETHANES (TTHM), HALOACETIC ACIDS, FIVE (HAA5).

What Should I Do?

This notice is to inform you that Twin City Water And Sewer District PWS did not monitor and report results for the presence of the contaminants listed above in the public drinking water system during the Second Quarter of 2013 time period, as required by the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency. You do not need to take any actions in response to this notice.

What Is Being Done?

Upon being notified of this violation, the water supply was required to have the drinking water analyzed for the above mentioned parameters. The water supplier will take steps to ensure that adequate monitoring will be performed in the future.
