Dear Mr. Peters:

Thank you for your written response dated August 5, 2013, as well as for information shared with me in telephone conversations. You indicated your spent paint filters and your spent blasting media both tested hazardous for chromium using the TCLP analysis. As such, you are managing these waste streams as hazardous waste. The volume of these two additional waste streams does not appear to be enough to require your facility to comply with the large quantity generator rules. Parker is still considered a small quantity generator of hazardous waste.

Based on this information, we consider your facility to have adequately addressed the one outstanding violation regarding hazardous waste determination, OAC 3745-52-11 and 40(C).
