Thank you for your May 6, 2008, May 23, 2008, June 26, 2008, June 27, 2008, and June 30, 2008 responses to Ohio EPA's May 5, 2008, Notice of Violation letter. The documentation you submitted included photographic documentation demonstrating that the satellite accumulation containers are now closed and properly labeled. Documentation also received demonstrated that Seifert Construction, Inc. has obtained a U.S. EPA Identification Number. My review of all of the documentation reveals that Seifert Construction, Inc. has now abated all violations discovered during the April 23, 2008 inspection as listed below:


