Dear Mr. Adair:

On August 1, 2007, I conducted a complaint investigation of A & A Engine Installers in Columbus, Ohio. The complainant alleged that the company is storing uncapped drums of oil and antifreeze outside and that the drums overflow onto the ground when it rains. The complainant also stated the company is pouring the antifreeze down the drain. This letter explains the findings of my investigation.

During the investigation, I reviewed your facility operations and written documentation.

I found the following violations of Ohio's used oil laws. In order to correct these violations you must do the following and send me the required information **within 30 days of your receipt of this letter.**

1.) Used Oil Generator Standards (OAC 3745-279-22(C))


Containers and aboveground tanks used to store used oil at generator facilities shall be labeled or marked clearly with the words "Used Oil."

A & A Engine Installers had not properly labeled the 250-gallon used oil tank, 275-gallon tote, or other containers that hold used oil with the words "used oil." The company must properly label all containers, tanks, and tote with the words "used oil." Please submit photos of the properly labeled containers, tanks, and tote in order to abate this violation.

2.) Used Oil Generator Standards (OAC 3745-279-22(D))

Upon detection of release of used oil to the environment that has occurred after October 20, 1998, a generator shall perform the following cleanup steps: 1) stop the release; 2) contain the released used oil; 3) clean up and manage properly the released used oil and other materials; and 4) If necessary, repair or replace any leaking used oil storage containers or tanks prior to returning them to service.

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A & A Engine Installers has a 250-gallon used oil tank along with a tote and some containers of used oil outside the facility. Ohio EPA observed used oil on the ground around the used oil tank. During the complaint investigation, you stated the company was in the process of installing a concrete pad to place the used oil tote. The used oil on the ground needs to be excavated and properly disposed. In order to abate this violation, the facility must send Ohio EPA a photo of the area after it has been properly cleaned and photos of the concrete pad.
