**Subject: Failure to Monitor Drinking Water**

PICKET FENCES MOBILE HOME COMMUNITY is in violation of Ohio Administrative Code Rule 3745-81-24 for failing to monitor your drinking water during the July 1, 2009 to September 30, 2009 monitoring period and/or report results for the following contaminants: TOTAL HALOACETIC ACIDS (HAA5), TOTAL TRIHALOMETHANES (TTHM).

PICKET FENCES MOBILE HOME COMMUNITY must promptly take the following actions.

- A. If sample was taken during this monitoring period,**
  - a. Call your laboratory and have them submit the results to Ohio EPA.
  - b. Contact this office at (614) 644-2752 to consult with us on this issue.

- B. If sample was not taken during or after this monitoring period,**
  - a. Take a sample of your drinking water between July 1, 2010 and September 30, 2010. This sample should be collected at the point in the distribution where the age of the water is the oldest.
  - b. Submit the sample for analysis to a certified laboratory on the enclosed list.

- C. If sample was taken after this monitoring period, contact this office at (614) 644-2752.**

Your prompt attention to this matter is appreciated. Continued failure to sample during your scheduled time period may lead to enforcement which may include penalties. If you have questions, please call me at (614) 644-2752.
