Dear Mr. Ringlein:

The City of Toledo was issued a Notice of Violation (NOV), on August 30, 2013 for initiating demolition at Fire Station #3, 701 Bush Street, Toledo prior to submittal of a notification of demolition. The NOV requested a response by September 11, 2013 with a completed notification of demolition and confirmation that the City understands the notification requirements contained in Ohio Administrative Code, 3745-20. At this time a completed notification and a response has been received.

Through submittal of the completed notification, continued correspondence, and general cooperation regarding this matter the City of Toledo has returned to compliance.

Please note that the submission of any requested information to respond to this letter does not constitute waiver of the Ohio EPA's authority to seek civil penalties as provided in Section 3704.06 of the Ohio Revised Code. Ohio EPA will determine later whether to pursue such penalties in this case.
