Thank you for your October 27, 2009, response (received via email) to Ohio EPA's October 14, 2009, Notice of Violation letter. Your company's timely communication and actions to return to compliance are greatly appreciated. You provided evidence of corrections related to:

1. **Hazardous Waste Evaluation, OAC rule 3745-52-11:** The waste used nickel solution was evaluated, is now marked as a hazardous waste, and will be disposed to Chemtron by the end of this month.
2. **Satellite Accumulation Container Marking, OAC rule 3745-52-34(C)(1)(b):** The satellite accumulation container of "Cleansol 101 waste" in the paint booth area, has been properly marked to identify the contents.

At this time, Bron Shoe has adequately demonstrated abatement of all violations previously noted at your 1313 Alum Creek Drive facility during the September 1, 2009 inspection.
