Thank you for the photos (received via email on May 16 and July 27, 2011) in response to Ohio EPA's July 10, 2008, Notice of Violation letter and subsequent correspondence. Violations # 1, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8 noted during my June 19, 2008, inspection at the ICS-OH facility at 1385 Blatt Boulevard have already been resolved, and now so is the last remaining one:

Letter Citation #	Rule Citation
2.	OAC rule 3745-65-31, Preparedness and Prevention. The floor and first block course of the walls in this area are now sealed with an epoxy coating. Waste conveyance to the hazardous waste tank and oily caustic reclamation area is now being done via flex-hoses, allowing the trench to function as secondary containment. These measures reduce the possibility of unplanned releases of hazardous waste from waste generation and management operations in the area.

Your photos appeared to show some deterioration of the floor coating applied in February. ICS will need to regularly inspect and periodically maintain this coating to provide an intact functioning protection against migration of any potential spills of liquid hazardous wastes in this area. There are various types of epoxy coatings which range in durability and thickness, which could be considered if needed over time to provide the desired continued preventive protection function.
