Ohio EPA, Division of Hazardous Waste Management (DHWM) sent a notice of violation (NOV) letter, dated January 2, 2008, to Perry Township as a result of a December 28, 2007 compliance evaluation inspection (CEI). During the inspection, as presented in the NOV, violations of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) rules regarding management of used oil filters were noted. The NOV specified that Perry Township abate these violations and respond to Ohio EPA within 30 days of receipt of the NOV letter. On March 6, 2008, due to a lack of response from Perry Township, a follow-up CEI was completed.

During the follow-up CEI, we discussed that township personnel had been and would continue to be instructed to puncture or crush the used oil filters and hot drain them, and that any container used to manage used oil had to be appropriately labeled. The above ground tank was appropriately labeled and smaller containers in the work area were labeled this day. Based upon the results of the follow-up CEI, it has been determined that Perry Township has now abated all violations discovered during the December 28, 2007 inspection as listed below.

We discussed that the Township had switched to the low-mercury green tipped fluorescent light tubes when needed. The old-type spent fluorescent tubes were being placed into a labeled container and would be collected by the Township's lighting supplier for recycling. We also discussed that continued compliance with the hazardous waste, used oil, and universal waste management rules was expected.
