Dear Mr. Horney:

This letter confirms my visit to your property at 12221 State Route 56 W, Mount Sterling, Ohio, wherein I observed that you were open burning in violation of Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) 3745-19-04(A). These actions are subject to fines and penalties.

Specifically, on July 22, 2013, you were open burning landscape waste within 1,000 feet from the nearest inhabited building off said premises. Additionally, there was evidence that you have recently burned tires, mattresses, copper wire and misc. plastic materials.

This letter is not a final action of Director of Ohio EPA and is intended only as a notification of a violation of the Ohio environmental laws and regulations. It does not preclude Ohio EPA or any other governmental entity from further enforcement action.
