This letter confirms my visit to your facility at 8866 Sportsman Club Road, Johnstown, wherein I observed that you had been open burning in violation of Ohio Administrative Code rule 3745-19-04(A). These actions are subject to fines and penalties.

Specifically, at Hillcrest Golf Course, 8866 Sportsman Club Road, you had open burned landscape waste. Additionally, you had open burned a tire. Additionally, this open burning had occurred within 1,000 feet from the nearest inhabited building off said premises

This letter is not a final action of the Director of the Ohio EPA and is intended only as a notification of a violation of the Ohio environmental laws and regulations. It does not preclude Ohio EPA or any other governmental entity from further enforcement action.
