WARNING LETTER

Dear Mrs. Haney:

On September 9, 2013, the Regional Air Pollution Control Agency (RAPCA) received an incident report from the Moorefield Twp. Fire Department regarding the open burning of a standing wood deck at the rear of your property at 825 Willow Road, Springfield, OH. The incident report documented that the open burning of the painted, treated wood deck was occurring at the rear of the property and an approximately six foot fire was burning upon the arrival of the Fire Dept. at 8:21 am on September 9, 2013. The open burning of painted, treated wood in an unrestricted area and within 1000 feet of a neighboring property is strictly prohibited.

This open burning is a violation of the following regulations:


- 1) Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) rule: 3745-19-04, Open Burning in an Unrestricted Area.
- 2) Clark County Combined Health District Air Pollution Control Regulations (CCCHDAPCR) rule: 3745-19-04, Open Burning in an Unrestricted Area.

This letter serves as an official warning from the Regional Air Pollution Control Agency to cease all open burning in violation of both state and local air pollution control regulations. In the future, alternative means of disposal must be employed. The manner of disposal must be in compliance with all air and solid waste regulations. Any future illegal burning may result in enforcement action against you which may include civil and/or criminal penalties.
