Thank you for submitting the requested information received by Ohio EPA on August 19, 2013. You submitted this information in response to my May 21, 2013, Notice of Violation. You emailed me the analytical reports of used fluorescent bulbs generated at the facility prior to being crushed. The analyses indicate that these type and brand of bulbs being currently used at your facility are non-hazardous.

My review of this documentation reveals that Broshco Fabricated Products has abated the violation discovered during the April 30, 2013, compliance evaluation inspection as listed below:


